



## Notice of Hearing: Registrant CM

The College of Registered Dental Hygienists of Alberta, as regulator of the dental hygienists profession under authority of the **Health Professions Act (HPA)**, operates to protect the public from unskilled practice and/or professional or ethical misconduct by its registrants and to hold them accountable for the care they provide.

Under authority of the HPA, some complaints of unprofessional conduct result in a formal hearing before a Hearing Tribunal. The Hearing Tribunal will consider evidence and determine if the dental hygienist is guilty of unprofessional conduct. A Hearing Tribunal consists of Registered Dental Hygienists appointed by CRDHA Council and members of the public appointed by government. This is notice of such a hearing.

## Hearing Notice

An investigation was undertaken into a complaint against registrant CM. Pursuant to sections 66(1), 66(3) and 69 of the *Health Professions Act*, a hearing will take place on the dates and times below:

December 15: 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and

December 16: 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Hearing Location: via ZOOM

In accordance with section 78 of the HPA, this hearing will be open to the public unless the Hearing Tribunal accepts a motion to close the hearing.
